Mike Madore, then 33, was last seen on April 6th, 1996. He disappeared from Milo, Maine. Mike reportedly left a note for friends stating that he was leaving town for Alaska and signing over all of his possessions (including two dogs) to them. Mike has not been seen since.

### Organizational Updates

Since January 1st through the end of March of this year, PIFTM has received 44 case requests. Of these requests, 6 met the criteria and were therefore accepted and assigned a Private Investigator. 2 are currently under review and awaiting more information. 1 was located by PIFTM without hiring a PI. 3 were located by family or police. The remainder were screened out due to eligibility requirements, however in several of these cases, PIFTM offered referrals and other forms of assistance to these cases.
