DONALD HEWITT, JR. is missing from Jackson, MS. He was last seen June 13 or 14, 2022, at the Moss Creek Apartments in Jackson. At the time of his disappearance, he was driving a dark gray 2014 Nissan Altima with MS license plate HNV 1377. The vehicle was found at the

Moss Creek Apartment parking lot. He is described as being 6 feet tall, 170lbs., with black hair and hazel eyes. NamUS #MP101583.
