## Featured Case: Missing Brittany Tee

Brittany was last seen leaving her residence on foot in Main Street in Brookfield, Massachusetts at 8:30 p.m. on January 10, 2023. She had her wallet and cellphone in her possession. Law enforcement has stated they do not suspect foul play in the Tee case, but the Tee family considers the disappearance out-of-character and suspicious.

## Organization Updates

Private Investigations for the Missing continues to accept intake requests for new cases and follows a screening process to determine eligibility. Cases that are screened in are assigned a case manager and investigator. PIFTM also provides victim and family advocacy services.

To date in 2024, PIFTM has received 179 case requests. 9 were determined to be eligible and were assigned investigators. 21 missing persons were located. PIFTM currently has 32 active cases across 23 states. The oldest case dates back to 1963, and the newest is a disappearance from 2023.
